Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting held on Tuesday 10th September at Thornford Village Hall

- Chairman's Opening Remarks The Chairman welcomed Councillors and local residents to the meeting. Normal rules of Council meetings would be relaxed so as to allow comments and questions from Councillors and then an hour would be allocated to allow for members of the public to raise as many issues as possible, but, please refrain from repeating issues. Following the time for questions, he would ask members of the public to leave so that Councillos can consider the next steps they wish to take. These will be reported at the next meeting on 18th September and on line.
- 2. Apologies for Absence Cllr Hoff, Cllr Rogers, Cllr Bromell.
- 3. Declarations of Interest None were declared.
- 4. Wyke Farm Solar Project the two representatives from RWE present gave a brief summary of the project. The next Public Consultation would take place at Bradford Abbas Village Hall on Monday 16th September 2024 4.00-7.00pm. The consultation period would close on 23rd September 2024. Any comments and feedback would then be used to inform the final design. An application to Dorset Council was expected in December.
